

ORDINANCE NUMBER: 2015-05

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE VILLAGE OF CHERRY VALLEY, ILLINOIS AMENDING THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES: CHAPTER 2, SECTIONS 2-33; 2-62 THROUGH 2-67; 2-71; 2-72; 2-115; AND 2-117

WHEREAS, the Ordinance Committee for the Village of Cherry Valley, Illinois, has been reviewing Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances and has found outdated material and inconsistency with state law in some of the sections of Chapter 2; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has reviewed and discussed the suggested changes to those sections of Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances and is in agreement with the modifications to those sections as contained in this ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, in order to modify the sections of Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Cherry Valley, Illinois, it is necessary to enact this ordinance.

NOW, WHEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE VILLAGE OF CHERRY VALLEY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 2-33. Committees. Shall and hereby is amended to delete Subsection (c) and replace the current version of Subsection (c) with the following language:

(c)(1). All standing committees shall be composed of a maximum of three (3) members, including the chairperson. All committees shall be appointed by the Village President with the advice and consent of the Village Board.

(c)(2). All special committees shall be composed of a maximum of three (3) members, including the chairperson. All special committees shall be appointed by the Village President with the advice and consent of the Village Board.

SECTION 2: Section 2-33. Committees (e). Shall and hereby is amended to remove from this section the following:

“Village Board of Trustee Meetings: First and Third Tuesdays” and shall replace with

“Zoning Board of Appeals: First and Third Tuesdays”.

The following Committee shall also be added to subsection (e):

“Planning and Zoning Commission: Third Wednesday”.

SECTION 3: Section 2-62. Special meetings; call; notice. Shall and hereby is amended to read as follows:

Special Village Board Meetings; call; notice. Special Village Board Meetings may be called by the President or by any three (3) Trustees upon notice in accordance with 5 ILCS 120/2.02(a).

SECTION 4: Section 2-63. President to be presiding officer. Shall and hereby is amended to read as follows:

The Village President shall be the presiding officer of all regular and special board meetings of the Board of Trustees.

SECTION 5: Section 2-64. Quorum; required votes. Shall and hereby is amended to read as follows:

A majority of the Board of Trustees shall constitute a quorum to conduct business, but no amendment to this Code or any ordinance shall be passed except by a favorable vote by a majority.

SECTION 6: Section 2-65. Order of business (7) Citizen's voice. Shall and hereby is amended to delete the following:

"Citizen's Voice" and shall replace said phrase with "Public Comment".

Said Section shall be further amended to add the following:

- (15) "Executive Session"; and,
- (16) "Reconvene to Open Session".

Said Section shall be further amended to read (17) Adjournment.

SECTION 7: Section 2-66. Motions for reconsideration and rescission. Subsection (1) Motions for reconsideration (a) shall and hereby is amended to read as follows:

- (a) Applicability. Motions for reconsideration are applicable to all standing committee meetings, planning and zoning commission meetings, and board of trustee meetings.

SECTION 8: Section 2-67. Resolutions to be reduced to writing. Shall and hereby is amended to read as follows:

Any resolution submitted to the Board of Trustees shall be presented in writing before being voted upon.

SECTION 9: Section 2-71. Trustee reimbursement. (b). Shall and hereby is amended to read as follows:

(b). The twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars per meeting reimbursement to each member of the Board of Trustee shall be payable on a bi-weekly basis. The trustees who are designated as ex officio members of the planning and zoning commission and the recreational board shall be entitled to reimbursement pursuant to this section for those meetings attended.

SECTION 10: Section 2-72. Teleconference meeting. (e). Shall and hereby is amended to read as follows:

(e) Trustees shall be allowed to participate by way of teleconference. The public shall not be allowed to participate by teleconference.

SECTION 11: Section 2-115. Expenses of Village Trustee and Village President. Shall and hereby is amended to add the current state statute allowing reimbursement for expenses which is 65 ILCS 5/3.1-50-15(b).

SECTION 12: Section 2-117. Employment of Personnel. The third (3rd) sentence shall and hereby is amended to read as follows:

Compensation for approved positions shall be established by the Personnel, Compensation and Benefits Committee upon recommendation by the department head and approval by the full Board of Trustees.

SECTION 13: Except as modified in Sections 1-12 above, the Code Sections as they previously existed and were printed shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 14: This Ordinance shall become in full force and effect from and after its approval, passage and publication in pamphlet form.
