

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-32

AN ORDINANCE REVISING CHAPTER 2, "ADMINISTRATION", ARTICLE II BOARD OF TRUSTEES, DIVISION 1, "GENERALLY", SECTION 2-32 "COMPENSATION" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHERRY VALLEY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees for the Village of Cherry Valley, Illinois previously adopted Chapter 2, Administration, Article II Board of Trustees, Division 1, Generally, Section 2-32 Compensation; in the Village of Cherry Valley Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees now desires to amend Section 2-32 "Compensation" of the Village of Cherry Valley Code of Ordinances;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees for the Village of Cherry Valley, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: The above recitals are incorporated herein and made part hereof.

SECTION 2: That Section 2-32 entitled, "Compensation" is hereby amended to read as follows: (revised language strikethrough, new language in bold):

Sec. 2-32. - Compensation.

- (a) Effective May 1, 2019, the salary of all trustees or their successors in office, shall be **\$200.00 for each official board meeting and \$75.00 per official committee meeting** attended by such trustees or their successors. During any one fiscal year, each trustee shall be allowed to miss no more than two regularly scheduled board **or committee** meetings of the board of trustees for the village, and the treasurer for the village is directed to pay the trustee as if the trustee had actually attended the meetings. To the extent that any member of the board of trustees misses more than two regularly scheduled board meetings **or committee meetings** ~~for the board of trustees~~, the trustee shall not be entitled to compensation for the board **or committee meetings** missed in excess of two meetings in any fiscal year.
- (b) ~~Effective May 1, 2007, the salary of all trustees or their successors in office shall be \$200.00 for each official board meeting. The provisions regarding attendance of the regularly scheduled board meetings as set forth in subparagraph (a) above shall also be applicable.~~

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of May 1, 2019 after its approval, passage and publication in pamphlet form.
