

**ORDINANCE NUMBER: 2016- 37**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR  
THE VILLAGE OF CHERRY VALLEY, ILLINOIS  
CHAPTER 2, ADMINISTRATION, ARTICLE III, OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES,  
DIVISION 1, GENERALLY, SECTIONS 2-119(d) AND 2-120(d)**

**WHEREAS**, the Ordinance Committee for the Village of Cherry Valley, Illinois, has been reviewing Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances; and

**WHEREAS**, as part of its review of Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances, the Ordinance Committee for the Village of Cherry Valley, Illinois has reviewed the Village's policy regarding meal allowance expenses for both Village employees and Village officials; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ordinance Committee for the Village of Cherry Valley, Illinois, is of the belief that amounts provided for reimbursable meal allowances for both Village employees and officials should be increased when said employee or official is traveling in Cook County or in a municipality with a population greater than 500,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees has reviewed and discussed the suggested changes to those sections of Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances and is in agreement with the modifications to those sections as contained in this ordinance; and,

**WHEREAS**, in order to modify the sections of Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Cherry Valley, Illinois, it is necessary to enact this ordinance.

**NOW, WHEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE VILLAGE OF CHERRY VALLEY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1:** The above-recitals are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

**SECTION 2:** Section 2-119, entitled "Travel allowances for Village Employees", subsection (d), shall and hereby is amended to read as follows (amended language in **bold** and underline):

(d) *Meal allowance.* Village employees may be reimbursed for an amount up to \$50.00 per day for reasonable meal expenses while traveling in collar counties, and for an amount up to \$75.00 per day for reasonable meal expenses while traveling in Cook County or in any municipality wherein the population exceeds 500,000. Such expenditures must be verified by expense receipts submitted to the Village in accordance with subsection (f) of this Section. In the event that meal expenses total greater than \$50.00 per day in a collar county, the employee shall be responsible for the amount that exceeds \$50.00. In the event that meal expenses total greater than \$75.00 per day in Cook County or in any municipality wherein the population exceeds 500,000, the employee shall be responsible for the amount that exceeds \$75.00.

**SECTION 3:** Section 2-120, entitled "Travel allowances for Village Officials", subsection (d), shall and hereby is amended to read as follows (amended language in **bold** and underline):

(d) *Meal allowance.* Village officials may be reimbursed for an amount up to \$50.00 per day for reasonable meal expenses while traveling **in collar counties, and for an amount up to \$75.00 per day for reasonable meal expenses while traveling in Cook County or in any municipality wherein the population exceeds 500,000.** Such expenditures must be verified by expense receipts submitted to the Village in accordance with subsection (f) of this Section. In the event that meal expenses total greater than \$50.00 per day **in a collar county,** the official shall be responsible for the amount that exceeds \$50.00. **In the event that meal expenses total greater than \$75.00 per day in Cook County or in any municipality wherein the population exceeds 500,000, the official shall be responsible for the amount that exceeds \$75.00.**

**SECTION 4:** Except as modified in Sections 2-119(d) and 2-120(d) above, the Code Sections as they previously existed and were printed shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 5:** This Ordinance shall become in full force and effect from and after its approval, passage and publication in pamphlet form.
