NEW BUSINESS:

1. Discussion and possible Liquor Commission action regarding a request from Kegal's Harley-Davidson 7125 Harrison Avenue, Rockford, Illinois, regarding Special Event Permits and Liquor Licenses for their Summer 2015 Event Schedule. Representatives from Kegal's Harley Davidson, Mark Kegal and Katrina Kegal-Mathers, are present to answer questions. Their question is, what does Kegal's or the not-for-profit organizations need to do in order to have bike nights on the following nights; May 22, 2015, June 12, 2015, June 22, 2015, July 10, 2015, July 24, 2015, August 14, 2015, August 28, 2015 and September 11, 2015.

Since there are eight different organizations that would need to apply, they would each have to show proof, or certificate for a recognized 501 C not-for-profit organization status, be within the Winnebago-Boone County area, proof of liability insurance and pay a fee of \$5.00 with the proper application for a Class F liquor permit. (For clarity, if the dealership applies, the license would be \$100.00 per event. If the not-for-profit organizations apply for the license, it would be \$5.00 per event). The applications would need to be sent to the Village Hall at a minimum of one month in advance in order to be processed in a timely manner.

Katrina Kegal-Mathers stated that the events would be cordoned off, wristbands would be used, and event participants would have to be 21 years of age or older. Attorney Stevens inquired about numbers: Katrina Kegal-Mathers added that there is enough parking for 200 vehicles and the organizations would need to provide security. President Claeysen noted that the Police Department needs to be informed of the security details. President Claeysen stated that once applications are received they will be sent to the Village Board for approval.
