1. Chairman Fustin moved to send to the Village Board on June 21, 2016 a request to authorize Chief of Police Larry Neville to send Office Nyman to the IATAI (Illinois Association of Technical Accident Investigators) training conference in East Peoria, Illinois from September 19-23, 2016 at a cost not to exceed \$1,165.00 with \$350.00 from line item 5195P Training and \$815.00 from 5200P Travel. Trustee Schroeder seconded. All "Aye"; none opposed. Motion carried by voice vote.

Chairman Fustin moved to send to the Village Board on June 21, 2016 a request to authorize Chief of Police Larry Neville to allow Sergeant Jesse Pearse to participate in the Northwestern University's School of Police Staff and Command online program. The course will run from September 12, 2016 - February 26, 2017 and he will earn six units of credit. The cost of the training is \$4,000 from line item 5195P Training. Trustee Belt seconded. All "Aye"; none opposed. Motion carried by voice vote.

Chief of Police Larry Neville shared with Committee Members a copy of an Intergovernmental Agreement for Electronic Citation Program Fees for the Boards' information at this time. Chairman Fustin moved to send to the Village Board for discussion and possible action on June 21, 2016 the e-citation proposal. Trustee Schroeder seconded. All "Aye"; none opposed. Motion carried by voice vote.
