ADOPT THE AGENDA: Dan Jarocki moved to adopt the amended agenda. *NEW BUSINESS* will go before *UNFINISHED BUSINESS* and add item number 4. *Jackets* under *UNFINISHED BUSINESS*. Natalie Scibona seconded. Motion carried.

APPROVE THE MINUTES: Natalie Scibona moved to approve the minutes from the June 1, 2016 meeting. Stacey Chester seconded. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. **National Night Out** - Sergeant Pearse recapped what he has ready for National Night Out on August 2, 2016 at the Baseball Diamond. Pepsi advertisement signs will be put out on Monday July 11th. Salamone's agreed to sell pizza by the slice again at \$2.00 per slice, and Sergeant Pearse stated that he was going to buy juice and water instead of soda for National Night Out this year. Sergeant Pearse informed recreation board that there will be no bouncy house this year since it caused problems last year. A relay race will be played before the kickball game in place of the bounce house to occupy time before the kickball game begins. Jill Wedig ordered 18 red shirts and 18 blue shirts for the kickball game, and noted that we still have a four volunteer shirts left from last year. Lori Kuhn will print out 100 \$1.00 bomber pop coupons to give away as prizes to the kids.
2. **Street Dance (September 17, 2016)** - The Street dance will be September 17, 2016 from 3:00 PM -7:00 PM. Heather Church gave Lori Kuhn the names and numbers of 3 Country and Blue Grass bands to contact for the Street Dance, since the previous 4 bands were unavailable. Jill Wedig reported that the Cherry Valley Orchard, Cherry Valley Fire, and Cherry Valley Police Department are interested in having a table set up for the Street dance. Stacey Chester stated that the Cherry Valley Library is also interested in having a table so that they can try and promote and sell some of their Scarecrows to decorate and line East State Street in town for the library fundraiser. Nothing else reported.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

1. **Movie Night** - Natalie Scibona returned \$61.01 back to the Village Hall, after \$16.99 in expenses (soda and water) and concession sales of \$18.00, a profit of \$1.01 was made selling popcorn and beverages. Natalie Scibona will use the left over soda and water from the movie night at National Night Out. Recreation Board decided that next year's Movie Night date will be June 17, 2017 and will be watching Finding Dory.
2. **Garden Walk** -Jill Wedig reported that the Garden Walk had a very good turnout. Kathy Trimble designed the posters that were printed out put up around town. There were 8 people that said they would be interested in participating in the Garden Walk next year. There were anywhere from 110 - 240 people who toured the gardens. Each garden exhibitor received a garden stone as a participation gift. They only suggestion that was brought to Jill's attention was to have directional signs for people who are not familiar with Cherry Valley. Nothing else reported.
3. **4th of July** - The parade had a great turn out. 28 corvettes attended the parade with 23 from the Northern Illinois Corvette Club. \$70.61 were returned to the Village. Recreation board will be upping their budget for the 4th of July Parade next year as 4 dozen new flags need to be ordered and possibly increase the prize amount for the "Anything with Wheels" winners. The firetruck needs to be at the beginning of the parade so that if the Fire Department gets a call they are able to leave and handle emergency situations. Coley's Coolers participated in the parade and gave out free red, white, and blue bomber pops. All participants that decorated a bike in the parade received a goody bag with a 50-cent piece, DQ ice cream cone coupon, and candy. Nothing else reported.
4. **Jackets** - Recreation Board has decided they will not be purchasing jackets from Twin Towers. Recreation Board might buy their own sweaters/jackets and pay out of pocket to get them embroidered. Nothing else reported.

ADJOURNMENT: Chairman Kuhn entertained a motion to adjourn. Jill Wedig moved to adjourn at 8:45 PM. Stacey Chester seconded. Motion carried.
