Consensus from people who attended was that they did preferred the September Street Dance date rather than the July Street Dance because the weather is cooler. The popcorn popper did not work because it was missing a pin in the top that rotated the kernels while it cooked so it did not work properly. Public Works will fix the pin for the popcorn popper. The Wilhemi's donated their bags set to be used at the Street Dance. Some of the leather bags they provided ended up being broken. The Recreation Board provided the Wilhemi's a gift card for \$50 to replace the broken bags.
3. **Event Cards** - 150 more event cards are needed for the Halloween parade to be passed out. Natalie Scibona will pick the event cards up from Village Hall when she picks up the Halloween money, and attach the cards to the Halloween goody bags. Nothing else reported.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

- 1. Halloween** - The Halloween Parade is Saturday October 29<sup>th</sup> and will begin at 4:00 pm. Natalie Scibona will pick up \$650 from the Village Hall. Jean Johnson-citizen of the year, Jane Lenser- library director, and Jim Claeysen-Village President will judge the costume contest. Still waiting to hear from the Shell Express lane if they will judge also. Jill Wedig will contact Sergeant Pearse and see if the explorers are available to volunteer with the Halloween parade and games. Dina Brandt will get 16 dozen cookie and 6 pounds of frosting for cookie decorating.
- 2. Santa** - Mr. and Mrs. Claus will be at the log cabin on November 27<sup>th</sup>. Jill Wedig will contact George and Nancy Belt to confirm that they will still volunteer for this event. Jill Wedig reported that she is keeping an eye out for when the hot chocolate and holiday napkins go on sale so she can purchase them. Nothing else reported.
